### **MI-AMTE Rheta Rubenstein Service Award**

The Rheta Rubenstein Service to Michigan teacher educators award was created to honor members who have exhibited exemplary service to our organization, our state, the mathematics teacher education community, and the profession. This will be awarded every other year. The award recipient will receive a plaque and be recognized at the MI-AMTE CaC meeting.

#### Criteria

The nominee should be an active member of MI-AMTE and must have demonstrated statewide commitment and service to mathematics teacher education through one or more of the following areas:

- 1. Significant service and contributions to the mission and goals of MI-AMTE.
- 2. Active promotion and participation to promote quality mathematics teacher education in Michigan.
- 3. Key statewide leadership roles to develop and improve mathematics teacher education.
- 4. Active participation to support mathematics teachers at pre-service and/or in-service levels.
- 5. Active promotion and participation in a variety of partnerships that have advanced mathematics teacher education.

#### **Nomination and Review Process**

The call for the award will be advertised through an email, the MI-AMTE website, and social media platforms. MI-AMTE members can nominate a mathematics teacher educator who meets the criteria of the award with a letter of nomination documenting the nominee's eligibility for the award and addressing the criteria listed above. A current vita of the nominee highlighting the excellence in service to mathematics teacher education will be requested. All application materials should be submitted as PDF files to the MI-AMTE president by January 15th of the awarding year. The MI-AMTE board will receive applications and review the materials using the rubric below and select the award winner.
